# COVID-19 Vaccine Is Available For Ages 70 And Older In Lawrence County at the Lawrenceburg Health Department


Officials have announced that COVID-19 vaccinations are now available for Lawrence County residents who are 70 years of age and older. This is a reduction from the previous age eligibility that was 75 and older.

Vaccinations are by appointment only. Residents wishing to receive the COVID-19 vaccine should enter their name on the First Dose Priority Waiting list which is available on line at:
